TOURNAMENT RULES

All regular N.A.S.C. Softball Rules 2010 rules shall apply with the following exceptions

1. All tournament schedules will be a double knockout draw or a Round Robin Series. If the teams are placed in the Round Robin Series refer to the Oshawa N.A.S.C. Round Robin Rules.
2. Any team player(s), coach, manager or any other team official thrown out of a game shall not participate in any further tournament games. With No Exceptions!
3. All first game winning teams shall play in the winners' bracket until that team suffers their first loss.
4. All teams, upon suffering their first loss, shall drop into the losers' bracket.
5. Teams shall be eliminated from competition when they suffer their second loss.
6. For Mite and up
All tournament games, excluding Championship finals, shall adhere to a one (1) hour and thirty (30) minute time limit or seven (7) innings. (No full inning shall start after the one (1) hour and thirty (30) minute time limit has elapsed. The Championship final are one hour(1) forty five (45) minutes.. All Minor Mite games shall adhere to one (1) hour and thirty (30) minute time limit or five (5) innings. (No full inning shall start after the one (1) hour and thirty (30) minute time limit has elapsed. The International tie breaking rule will be in effect. In the event of a tie, the International tie breaking rule will be used. The person in the batting order furthest from the batter goes to second base.
7. There shall be no in field practices on the diamond at any tournament game.
8. In the Championship Final, the team from the losers' bracket must defeat the team from the winners' bracket twice in order to win the Championship.
9. Each team must supply one new or one good softball for each tournament game.
10. Before the start of each tournament game, the umpire shall flip a coin to decide the home team.
11. Each team must bring one set of bases to all tournament games.
12. There shall be a Mercy Rule whereby a complete game will be declared if one team is leading by eleven (11) or more runs after the completion of the fifth (5) inning, or any succeeding inning.
13. All Friday night games are to be reported by phone to the respective league Convenors immediately after the game.
14. During the tournaments, all teams must report the final score to a Convenor located at their tournament site. Failure to report scores may result in forfeiture of the win
15. Due to unforeseen reasons beyond our control,(weather, diamond conditions) tournament games may be shortened.
- 16 June Tournament games will not be rescheduled in the event of a rain out.**
